What do I ask a client with a history of...

Liver Enzymes - Elevated

Elevated liver enzymes can indicate that a person has liver and/or gallbladder disorders. The liver enzymes are alanine aminotransferase (ALT), aspartate aminotransferase (AST), gamma glutamyl tranpeptidase (GGT, GGTP), and alkaline phospatase (ALP).

Questions:

- How old is the client and when was he/she discovered to have elevated liver enzymes?
- What is the diagnosed cause of the elevation?
- Does the client smoke?
- How much alcohol does the client drink?
- Is the client being treated for the elevation?
- What medications is the client currently taking?
- Does the client have any other medical concerns?
